PremiumDB Pro Quick Start

This guide gives the fastest path from download to first use.

1. Upload

Upload the premiumdb_admin folder to your web server.

2. Create Database

Create a new MySQL/MariaDB database for PremiumDB. Keep the database name, username, and password handy.

3. Run Installer

Open /premiumdb_admin/install/install.php. Enter database credentials and create the first admin login.

4. Confirm Login

After install completes, click Go to Login and sign in.

5. Secure Install

Delete or rename the install folder after login works.

6. Add/Test Connections

Use the Connections section to add remote or additional database servers.

7. Back Up Before Changes

Create a backup before running major SQL, editing privileges, restoring databases, or applying updates.

8. Update Workflow

- Back up your current folder and database.
- Apply patch ZIP through the updater or manually on a test server.
- Hard refresh the browser.
- Verify version and core workflows.
